Getting support

Group 1 - is for anyone who knows someone who has been diagnosed with cancer, or who has undergone treatment and not yet recovered.

Group 2 - is for those whose loved one's treatment has not proved to be successful and who are having to come to terms with the difficult outcome.

Group 3 - is for those who are dealing with bereavement due to cancer.

At each meeting there is the opportunity to express thoughts and feelings in a supportive and caring atmosphere.
